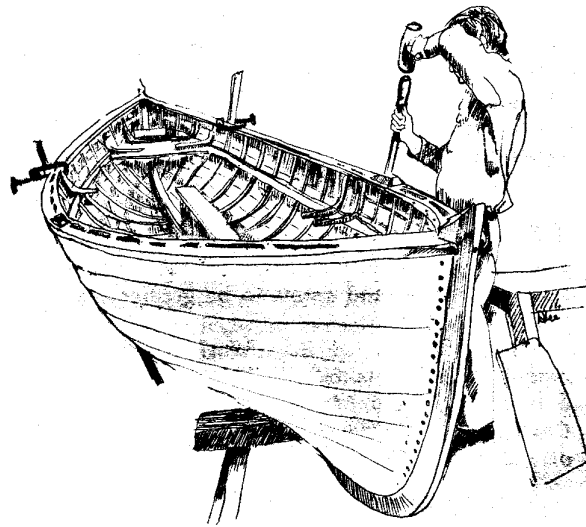


Oarlock & Sail Wooden Boat Club

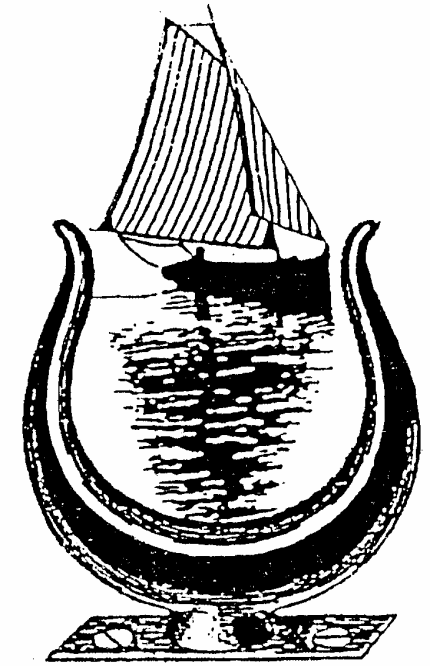

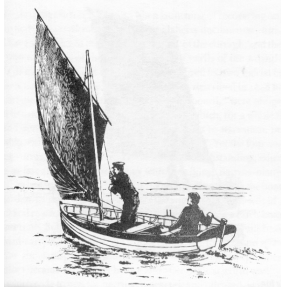

The Oarlock and Sail Wooden Boat Club was founded in 1995 by a small group of wooden boat enthusiasts. The founders' goal was to make using and building wooden boats accessible to as many people as possible. Today this is being achieved through educational and social activities sponsored by the Club.

Monthly Meetings

Monthly meetings are held September through June, on the third Thursday of each month. Meetings feature presentations and workshops dealing with various aspects of boatbuilding, small boat seamanship and boat maintenance. The club also organizes field trips and on-the-water events.

Newsletter

Members receive an informative newsletter three times a year.

Group Projects

The Club organizes group boatbuilding projects that give interested members the opportunity to gain hands-on experience.

Boat Users Group

Subject to meeting boating skill requirements (as set out in the Oarlock and sail Boat Users Group application form), and payment of an additional user's fee, club members may row and sail in the club's fleet of small wooden boats.
